

SENATOR WANZEK: Opened on SCR # 4050.

SENATOR WANZEK:

As I said Chairman Nicholas this is a joint hearing so these are Senate Resolutions, delayed Resolutions that have to go to the Senate Floor first, but I felt by having a joint hearing we would kill two birds with one stone. It came to my attention late in March that there might be a need for the Durum CRC Resolution and it basically asks the congress to direct the secretary of Agriculture in the Federal Risk Management to establish a pricing policy so crops, revenue covers for durum can be continued. I think that those of you who have raised Durum, I am not a Durum raiser personally but those who are raising Durum know that about a week before the dead line they pulled CRC and

a lot of farmers again were making their plans based on this kind of insurance and it seemed kind of unfortunate that they did that with just a week to go before the dead line gave them very little time to make alternative plans to change things off. If it was going to be done, it should have been done long before then. There were some members including the Farm Bureau President who brought an appeal to the Federal Court and Judge Web pretty much said everything in favor of the farmers but the ruling because his hands were somewhat tied. He felt that was obvious move that was negative to Durum Farmers. This Durum CRC Resolution just asks them to continue and to set the pricing I think that some of these individuals that they have this support, they can take it with them to D.C. and hopefully make some changes as to risk management about trying to correct what was done.


