## HB 1146 Senate Judiciary Committee February 16, 2009 Testimony of H. Jean Delaney North Dakota Commission on Legal Counsel for Indigents

House Bill 1146 deals with a couple of changes to the Chapter that governs this agency. It clarifies that services are provided to "indigent" persons, and that determinations of indigency are made based on consistent standards across the state. It also cleans up the language in section 54-61-04 to provide that certain records regarding a "party," not just a "defendant" are confidential. The Commission provides indigent services to juveniles, and others, who are not technically "defendants."
