Rep. Jason Dockter is a sponsor and support of this bill.

Lonnie Wangen, Commissioner of Veterans' Affairs for North Dakota, appeared in support of HB 1310. We want to do a little housekeeping and take the conservatorship option off so in the future our CVSOs when they are serving our veterans are serving them to get their benefits but not doing any fiduciary conservator work on their county time and causing a conflict of interest.

Chairman Jim Kasper Explain what the conflict was.

**Lonnie Wangen** You serve a veteran and you get them their benefits. The VA can determine that they are not capable of taking care of their own finances. They are going to find a conservator or fiduciary to do their checkbook work for them so you pay their bills. This can happen while you are on a job. You pick up 5% of the check they have gotten. You can see where the conflict could come in.

There was no opposition.

The hearing was closed.

Rep. Karen Karls made a motion for a Do Pass.

Rep. Karen Rohr seconded the motion.

**Chairman Jim Kasper** Obviously, we don't want conflicts of interest and when the affected parties recognize things need to be fixed, this does it. It was a noble experiment that did not work.

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A roll call vote was taken and resulted in **DO PASS**, 13-0, 1 ABSENT. Rep. Jason **Dockter** is the carrier.

### Explanation or reason for introduction of bill/resolution:

A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 37-14-18 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to eligibility of county veterans' service officers to be appointed as conservators.

#### Minutes:

Chairman Dever: Opened the hearing on HB 1310.

Lonnie Wangen, Commissioner of Veteran's Affairs: Testified in support of the bill and to explain the bill. It comes from HB 1047 two sessions ago. Parameters were set with Veterans Affairs that we can be conservators or fiduciaries and that we cannot help a veteran in that capacity. It also made that clear for the county veteran's service officers as well. It became a conflict of interest. We had only one county that wore two hats where they were appointed as the county veteran's service officer and they were also the conservator for the county. In that case we added that last sentence there, page 2 line 1, where it leaves room for that. That county has determined that they won't do that again so we are removing that as it is a conflict of interest.

Lonnie Wangen: Yes.

Chairman Dever: It was worth it just for that. The bill is unnecessary otherwise.

Lonnie Wangen: Yes it just fixes what we added at the end of last session.
