3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-08-04.9 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as
follows:

6 20.1-08-04.9. Small game proclamation - Pheasants.

7 The

- 8 1. Except as provided in subsection 2, the governor, in the governor's proclamation, shall
9 prohibit a nonresident from hunting for the first seven days of the pheasant season on
10 land owned or private land enrolled by the department for the purposes of hunting or
11 on land for which the department pays in lieu of tax payments.

- 12 2. A nonresident with a valid ~~small game~~ hunting license may hunt ~~pheasant~~ during the
13 first seven days of the pheasant season if:

- 14 a. The nonresident is an ~~individual~~ participating landowner whose ~~owns~~ property is
15 enrolled in this state's private land open to sportsmen program;

- 16 b. The nonresident is named as a party to the cooperative agreement with the
17 department enrolling the nonresident's property in the private land open to
sportsmen program; and

- 18 eb. The nonresident hunts on the nonresident's property enrolled in the private land
19 open to sportsmen program.
