The Commission would like to standardize the Directors title to Executive Director. During the January 2021 special meeting the commission voted unanimously to support this change. When applying, I applied for the position of Executive Director. Upon accepting the position, I learned the position was referred to as Director, Executive Director and Executive Officer in different areas of the Century Code, Administrative Rules, job descriptions and others.
