Good afternoon, Representative Kasper -

This email provides a section-by-section explanation of House Bill 1398.

The bill was designed to encourage non-citizens, who become naturalized, to update their identification for the purposes of voting.

Non-driver photo identification cards and driver's licenses issued to non-citizens must be designed in a manner to <u>clearly</u> <u>make the card distinguishable</u> from a similar card issued to a citizen of the United States.

SECTION 1:

Section 1 of the bill amends Subsection 2 of Section 39-06-03.1.

Section 39-06-03.1 addresses when the Director of the Department of Transportation shall issue nondriver photo identification cards.

Subsection 2 of Section 39-06-03.1 specifically addresses when the director shall issue nondriver photo identification cards to **non-citizens**.

Section 1 of the bill adds the following requirements:

- Upon the issuance of a nondriver photo identification card under Subsection 2, requires the Department of
 Transportation to provide a written notice that indicates within 45 days following naturalization, the naturalized
 individual shall contact the Department of Transportation to update the individual's citizenship status.
- 2. Requires the Department of Transportation to replace the card, as long as the fee is paid. Current law uses "may" instead of "shall."
- 3. Requires the Department of Transportation to send the notice regarding naturalization to all individuals who obtained a nondriver photo identification card under Subsection 2, before August 1, 2023. August 1, 2023 is the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 2:

Section 2 of this bill is mechanically identical to Section 1. However, Section 2 addresses driver's licenses, not nondriver photo identification cards.

Section 2 of the bill amends Subsection 5 of Section 39-06-14. Section 39-06-14 addresses when the Director of the Department of Transportation shall issue operator's licenses commonly referred to as driver's licenses.

Subsection 5 of section 39-06-14 specifically addresses when the director shall issue an operator's license to <u>non-citizens</u>.

Section 2 of the bill adds the following requirements:

- 1. Upon the issuance of an operator's license under Subsection 5, requires the Department of Transportation to provide a written notice that indicates within 45 days following naturalization, the naturalized individual shall contact the Department of Transportation to update the individual's citizenship status.
- 2. Requires the Department of Transportation to replace the license, as long as the fee is paid. Current law uses "may" instead of "shall."
- 3. Requires the Department of Transportation to send the notice regarding naturalization to all individuals who obtained a license under Subsection 5, before August 1, 2023. August 1, 2023 is the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3:

Section 3 of the bill amends Subsection 1 of Section 39-06-14.2.

Section 39-06-14.2 addresses the database that holds the information for citizens who possess a nondriver photo identification card or driver's license.

Section 3 of the bill requires the Department of Transportation to update the database when a naturalized citizen obtains a "citizen" nondriver photo identification card or operator's license under Chapter 39-06.
