#### Senate Bill No. 2039

- Is a bill repealing the reports provided to the Workers' Compensation Review Committee.
- Section 1:
  - Page 1, lines 21-23. Removes the requirement that OAH and WSI provide a quarterly report on the statistical information regarding results under the case processing standards and policies to Legislative Management. OAH will still provide the report to the state advisory council on a quarterly basis.
- o Section 2:
  - Page 2, lines 22-23. Removes the requirement that WSI provide a status report on current pilot programs in accordance with NDCC Section 65-01-19.
- o Section 3:
  - Page 2, lines 24-25. Repeals NDCC Sections 65-01-19 and 65-03-05.
    - Section 65-01-19 removes the requirement that WSI provide legislative management with an annual report on the status of any current pilot programs and pilot programs completed within the previous twelve months.
    - Section 65-03-05 removes the requirement that WSI provide legislative council (this committee) with a biennial report on data relating to safety grants issued under Chapter 65-03.

Remember, just like any other agency, any individual lawmaker can request reports on pilot programs etc. Also, WSI already lists these programs on their website.

I ask the committee for a Do Pass recommendation, and I'll stand for any questions.
