FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Polygraph Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D.A.C. Art. 10-11, Detection of Deception Examiners, at 7:00pm, on Wednesday, October 13, 2021, in the Red River Room of the North Dakota State Capitol, located at 600 E. Boulevard Ave, Bismarck, ND 58505.

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to comply with recently amended state law. The proposed amendment address(es) the definitions, application processes and procedures, licensing and reciprocity, and professional conduct relating to the detection of deception examiners.

The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rulemaking implements House Bill No. 1345 enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning the detection of deception examiners.
