FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Transportation will hold a virtual public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin Code chapter 37-12 at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 15, 2020. This virtual public hearing will be held online as a live event on the NDDOT website www.dot.nd.gov, click “Public Meetings” under Quick Links. If you are unable to attend the virtual public hearing, space will be made available by appointment only on Tuesday, September 15, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. at the Transportation Building, 608 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota 58505. The purpose of the proposed amendments are to provide clarifications to current law and motor vehicle policies. The proposed amendment addresses current law, provide for ease of use of the general public, and clean up old, outdated rules.

The proposed amendment to chapter 37-12-02 is to amend section 37-12-02-01, Definitions, to amend the definition of “Special motor vehicles”; amend section 37-12-02-02, rearview mirror to remove the requirement for 2 mirrors.

The proposed amendment to chapter 37-12-04 is to amend section 37-12-04-01 to include the additional items required to complete this process.

The proposed amendment to chapter 37-12-05 is to amend section 37-12-05-01 to remove an incorrect reference to a repealed section of North Dakota Administrative Code and add clarification that a vehicle needs to be physically inspected.

The proposed amendment to chapter 37-12-06 is to amend section 37-12-06-01 to match fees being charged by the branch offices after implementation of system

modernization.

The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.00.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the Motor Vehicle Division, Transportation Building, 608 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota or viewed online at www.dot.nd.gov, under the Public Section. A copy of the proposed rules and/or regulatory analysis may be requested by writing the above address, calling (701) 328-2725, or by email at mv@nd.gov. Written or oral comments on the proposed rules sent to the above address or telephone number received by 5:00 p.m. Friday, September 25, 2020, will be considered. The Department will follow the public hearing format and will not respond to comments or address questions at the hearing.

In order to maintain social distancing guidelines due to COVID-19, those planning to attend the public hearing to address proposed rule changes to North Dakota Administrative Code Title 37 are asked to contact the North Dakota Department of Transportation at 701-328-2725 prior to 5 p.m., Monday, September 14 so that we may plan for the number of attendees. If you plan to attend the public hearing and will need special facilities or assistance relating to a disability, please contact the North Dakota Department of Transportation at the above telephone number, address, or email at least 15 days prior to the public hearing.
