## FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT ETHICS COMMISSION RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Ethics Commission will hold a public hearing to address proposed Ethics Commission Rules at 9:00 a.m. CT on June 3, 2020, at 101 Slate Dr. Suite #4, in Bismarck. The purpose of the proposed rules is to establish a complaint process and procedure. These rules implement HB 1521, enacted during the most recent legislative session and Article XIV of the North Dakota Constitution that became effective January 5, 2019. The proposed rules will have no fiscal impact and are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. These are not emergency rules.
