## FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT ETHICS COMMISSION RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Ethics Commission will hold a public hearing to address proposed Ethics Commission Rules at 9:00 a.m. CT on Sept 15, 2020, at 101 Slate Dr. Suite #4, in Bismarck. The purpose of the proposed rules is to implement Article XIV of the North Dakota Constitution, effective January 5, 2019, relating to allowable gifts between lobbyists and public officials. The proposed rules will have no fiscal impact and are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. These are not emergency rules.
