## NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Education Standards and Practices Board will hold a public hearing to address new rules to N.D. Admin. Code 67.1-02-02 on Friday, March 13, at 10:00 a. m. CST, at 2718 Gateway Avenue, Suite 204, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed rule is to implement requirements of 15.1-18-10 (4)-(7) enacted pursuant to 2019 S.B. 2015, Section 18.

The proposed amendment addresses enrollment in the state mentoring program for individuals who are issued permits to teach. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
