TAKE NOTICE that the Education Standards and Practices Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed adoptions to N.D. Admin. Code N.D. Admin. Code Section 67.1-02-02-02 at 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, July 30, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. at 2718 Gateway Avenue, Suite 204, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to adopt initial licensure rules for individuals with a documented disability who are unable to pass the required exams, or for individuals with an alternate access license, who after successive attempts, are unable to pass state required tests.

The proposed amendment addresses individuals who are unable to pass the state required exams.

The proposed rulemaking contains the language of SB 2199, defeated during the most recent legislative session, concerning teacher licensure. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
