## FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT, AMEND, REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Education Standards and Practices Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments and adoptions to N.D. Administrative Code, 67.1-02-01, 67.1-02-02-02, 67.1-02-02-13, 67.1-02-03, 67.1-02-03-06, 67.1-02-04, 67.1-02-05, 67.1-02-05-04.1, 67.1-02-06-01, and 67.1-04-03-01 at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, September 5, 2023, at 2718 Gateway Avenue, Suite 204, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed rules is to propose rules for House Bill 1304 (Special Education Authorization) from the 68<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session, to adopt rules for a special education minor equivalency, to adopt rules that allow national certification to be used as an applicant's reeducation credits, to adopt rules for a school psychologist scope of practice, to increase license fees, and general edits for clarity.

The proposed amendment is expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules and regulatory analysis may be reviewed at the office of the Education Standards and Practices Board, 2718 Gateway Avenue, Suite 204, Bismarck, ND.
