NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND AND REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that ND Human Resource Management Services (HRMS), in cooperation with the State Personnel Board, will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to and repeals of Administrative Code Article 4-07 Organization of Human Resource Management Services at 1:00 pm on December 2, 2021, in the Red River Room of the State Capitol. Written and oral comments will be accepted at the hearing.

The proposed rules will reflect the repeal of N.D.C.C. sections 54-06-14.1 and 54-06-14.2, and the creation and enactment N.D.C.C. section 54-06-14.7 as a result of HB 1058. ND Human Resource Management Services will also be amending rules of the Division relating to the following chapters of N.D. Administrative Code Article 4-07: N.D.A.C. 4-07-02 relating to salary administration procedures; N.D.A.C. 4-07-05 relating to recruitment and selection; N.D.A.C. 4-07-08 relating to working and inclement weather conditions and repealing N.D.A.C. 4-07-34.1 relating to local county social services merit systems.

The proposed amendments and repeals are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000, and neither the Governor nor any member of the Legislative Assembly requested a regulatory analysis.
