


Additional income - Section 3 appropriates any additional federal or other funds available to the Governor's office during the 2013-15 biennium

Elected officials' salary increases - Sections 4 and 5 provide the statutory changes increasing the Governor's and Lieutenant Governor's salaries by 4 percent each year. The Governor's annual salary is increased from the current level of \$117,001 to \$121,681 effective July 1, 2013, and to \$126,549 effective July 1, 2014. The Lieutenant Governor's salary is increased from the current level of \$90,829 to \$94,462 effective July 1, 2013, and to \$98,241 effective July 1, 2015.

Continuing Appropriations

Governor's Prevention and Advisory Council - North Dakota Century Code Section 54-07-07 - Appropriates any funding obtained by the council to discourage impaired driving and alcohol and drug abuse by minors
