

Other Sections in Bill

Additional income appropriation - Section 3 provides that, in addition to the amount appropriated as other funds, any other income from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other sources received by the North Dakota State University (NDSU) Extension Service, is appropriated for the purposes designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation for the 2011-13 biennium.

Transfer authority - Section 4 authorizes the transfer of appropriation authority between the Main Research Center, the branch research centers, NDSU Extension Service, and Northern Crops Institute and provides that any transfers be reported to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB).

FTE position adjustments - Section 5 authorize the State Board of Higher Education to adjust or increase FTE positions for the NDSU Extension Service and provides that any adjustments be reported to OMB.

Unexpended general fund - Excess income - Section 6 authorizes the continuation of any unexpended general fund appropriation and excess income received by the NDSU Extension Service into the 2015-17 biennium.
