Item Description

One-time funding - The Legislative Assembly, in Section 2 of House Bill No. 1013, identified \$414,500 of one-time funding, of which \$317,000 is from special funds available from trust fund distributions, rents, contributions, and service revenue; \$11,500 is from a grant from the Department of Public Instruction; and \$86,000 is from the federal Coronavirus Relief Fund, for LED lighting (\$33,000) and extraordinary repairs and capital assets (\$381,500).

Extraordinary repairs and capital assets - The Legislative Assembly provided a total of \$420,692 from special funds available from trust fund distributions, rents, contributions, service revenue, and grants and from the Coronavirus Relief Fund for extraordinary repairs and capital assets, of which \$381,500 is one-time funding, as follows:

Status/Result

The School for the Blind completed the LED lighting update in March 2022 within budget. See the **Extraordinary repairs and capital assets** section below for additional information.

The School for the Blind has purchased the vision screening devices and completed the flooring replacement within budget. Approximately one-half of the air conditioning unit replacements have been installed, totaling \$18,530.

The School for the Blind, working with a consultant, determined the heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) system would need additional components to be energy efficient. The cost exceeded the \$86,000 provided by the Legislative Assembly, so the Office of Management and Budget arranged a lease/purchase agreement for an additional \$120,280 with U.S. Bancorp Government Leasing and Finance, Inc., for a total of \$206,280. Work on the HVAC upgrades is anticipated to be complete summer 2022. The School for the Blind will begin making payments on the lease/purchase in June 2022.
