For purposes of regulating coal combustion 14 residuals, the term "ground water" means water below the land surface in a zone of saturation. 15 If a federal law or regulation is adopted pertaining to the use and disposal of coal combustion 16 residuals, this section does not prohibit the state from seeking state primacy of the federal 17 18 SECTION 2.
